

The National Hispanic University

Teacher Education Scholarship Application

Purpose: The intent of the National Hispanic University's Teacher Education Scholarship Programs is to assist qualifying students in funding their education as they pursue a Teaching Credential. These Scholarship Programs are designed to assist students with the costs of tuition and fees. NHU Teacher Education Scholarships are available for NHU Students who plan to pursue a Teaching Credential.

Deadlines/Availability: Applications will be accepted on an on-going basis. However, awards are limited to available funds. Applications will no longer be accepted if/when funds for the academic year have been exhausted.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a student at The National Hispanic University; NHU Scholarships are not transferable to other institutions
- Submit a complete NHU Teacher Education Scholarship Application to the Office of Financial Aid & Scholarship
- Must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 as a credential student and be in good academic standing
- Must be a United States citizen or eligible non-citizen (as defined by Federal Student Aid regulations)

Application Procedure:

- Submit complete NHU Teacher Education Scholarship Application to the Office of Financial Aid & Scholarship – *only complete applications will be considered for award.*
- Submit complete *FAFSA* to the Office of Financial Aid & Scholarship.
- Applications are reviewed by the NHU Teacher Education Department.
- A representative from the Teacher Education Department will interview students.
- Funds will be awarded based on eligibility and interview with Teacher Education representative.

Notes:

- Funds will be awarded upon notification from NHU Scholarship Committee Chairperson and/or Director of the Office of Financial Aid & Scholarship.
- Grades of "W," "F," "U," "I," or "NC," or dropping below half time enrollment may result in cancellation of scholarship award(s).
- Students on academic probation may not be eligible to receive scholarship funds.
